202/21 SUSPEND STANDING ORDERS FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SPEAK – The member of the public were present to hear the Parish Councils response to the local plan consultation.

204/21 SELBY DISTRICT LOCAL PLAN PREFERRED OPTIONS CONSULTATION – Resolved: To submit the following responses to the consultation:

- To object to further development in the Parish but to confirm agreement that, if further development was to happen, ULLE-K is the Parish Councils preferred site.
- To object to the proposed new settlement at Church Fenton Airbase because the site is too remote and lacks the necessary infrastructure, services and facilities to support it. The settlement would not be large enough to sustain a new secondary school so it would put more pressure on existing schools which are already operating at capacity. Without a train station within walking distance, residents at the settlement would be reliant to cars and without a plan for a major road improvement to by-pass the village of Ulleskelf, this would have a significant detrimental impact on the health and well-being of the existing resident of the Parish. The development would also result in the loss of the facilities and service currently offered by Leeds East Airport.
- To request clarification on whether the proposed new settlement includes the sports field and if it does, to object, as this site is used by existing residents for recreation purposes and it should be kept for this use in the future.
